ANONYMOUS TIBETAN, HUANGYAN COUNTY, ABUJA, SICHUAN PROVINCE, CHINA

“I am inside a ambulance right now. The telephone landlines have all been cut off. Just one minute ago [1345 GMT] there was a big commotion. The monks outside the monastery were shouting: 'Long Live the Dalai Lama!'”
